Recent graduates (within 18 months) from an accredited Master of Science in Nursing program, licensed in Alabama or Mississippi before the start of the residency program (depending on placement).

The program format will include precepted experiences, specialty rotations, simulation experiences, and didactic training with opportunities for continued employment based on availability upon completion of the residency.
